As part of an overall play area improvement project the provision of two permanent items of children's play equipment and the realignment and some additional boundary fencing. Proposed works on The Village Green.

Item 1: Zip Line (30m) with 47m2 Honeycomb Lawn Matting (Rubber) as safety surfacing. Located immediately outside of the boundary of the existing play area (A and B on Design).

Item 2: Robinia Forest Climber- includes Scramble Net and Traverse Rope - MOT Type 1 Stone (Sub base), 100mm depth as sub-base for resin Bound Mulch Safety Surfacing safety surfacing. Located immediately outside of the boundary of the existing play area but, by re-alignment of the existing fence line and providing additional fencing the Climber will be fully contained within the boundary of the play area (D and E on Design)

Item 3: Paled Timber Fencing, 1m high, 24m in length, covering an area of 70m2 (C on Design).
