



HUTTON CRANSWICK RAILWAY STATION

For many years platforms on our Hull/Scarborough line have provided a pleasant garden backdrop for travellers. Despite pandemic restrictions volunteers kept planting under control and maintained drought-resistant displays, with considerable work being carried out on the northbound station border. A small work party has cleared out some plants which were past their best. The In Bloom team is currently researching new plants which are suited to the dry conditions.



New volunteers undertook a re-paint/re-furbish of our replica train and have recently added two wooden planters shaped as trucks, constructed as a fundraiser by a resident in support of a local steam railway charity. These have added to the Station charm and directed funds towards an appropriate local cause. Another village feature is the Yorkshire Rose planting on the "Way of the Roses" national cycle route.

The Queen's Platinum Jubilee Weekend 2022

In 2022, Her Majesty The Queen will become the first British Monarch to celebrate a Platinum Jubilee, seventy years of service, having acceded to the throne on 6th February 1952 when Her Majesty was 25 years old.

An extended bank holiday, from Thursday 2nd to Sunday 5th June, will provide an opportunity for communities and people throughout the United Kingdom to come together to celebrate the historic milestone.

Thursday 2nd June

The Queen's Birthday Parade (Trooping the Colour): Over 1,400 parading soldiers, 200 horses and 400 musicians will come together in the traditional Parade to mark The Queen's official birthday, usually held on the second Saturday in June.

Platinum Jubilee Beacons: The United Kingdom's long tradition of celebrating Royal Jubilees, Weddings and Coronations with the lighting of beacons will be continued to mark the Platinum Jubilee.

Friday 3rd June

Service of Thanksgiving: A Service of Thanksgiving for The Queen's reign will be held at St Paul's Cathedral.

Saturday 4th June

The Derby at Epsom Downs: Her Majesty The Queen, accompanied by Members of the Royal Family, will attend the Derby at Epsom Downs.

Platinum Party at the Palace: The BBC will stage and broadcast a special live concert from Buckingham Palace .

Sunday 5th June

The Big Jubilee Lunch: Every year since the idea began in 2009 The Big Lunch has encouraged

communities to celebrate their connections and get to know each other a little bit better, coming together in a spirit of fun and friendship. In 2022 The Big Lunch will bring the Jubilee celebrations into the heart of every community.

People are invited to share friendship, food and fun with neighbours as part of the Platinum Jubilee celebrations. A Big Jubilee Lunch can be big or small - street party or picnic, tea and cake or a garden barbeque.

The Platinum Jubilee Pageant: A pageant featuring over 5,000 people from across the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth will take place against the backdrop of Buckingham Palace and the surrounding streets.

Jesus was a great teacher and he had the ability to accommodate himself to the crowd's ability to understand. He usually did this by teaching in parables. He had the ability to ensure people understood what he was saying by using the ordinary and familiar things which were around him. The parable of the Sower speaks to us of 'cultivating'. It tells of various kinds of soil, ways of sowing and bearing fruit and how they all relate to each other. Ever since the time of Genesis, God has quietly urged us to 'cultivate and care for the earth'.

Creation is a gift from God and he invites us to cultivate it, to care for it, to protect it and to be its Custodians. Last year when I had the privilege of being President of the Methodist Conference I met with hundreds of Farmers. We shared many topics - the Environment, Brexit, the Agricultural Bill, Tenancy, Mental Health, Loneliness, Diversification and many more issues, but at each meeting the Farmers have all spoken about being Custodians of the land given to them. For them the landscape is not just to make a living out of, it is so much more. For the landscape we see is the product of generations of skill and hard work. As one farmer said, 'It was never a conscious decision to go into farming to produce a landscape. My desire and drive to have a business was to produce food, but the two things have become increasingly interwoven. We produce food and we're producing this iconic landscape as well to the benefit of everyone—for me as a farmer and for the public at large'.

Farming has played a key role in shaping the countryside we all enjoy today. We live in rural East Yorkshire, among the beautiful rolling Wolds and recently I spent 11 years living surrounded by the outstanding natural beauty of Cumbria. The agricultural

community is to be thanked. Harvest Festival is a time to do so. Every sector, livestock, arable, horticulture, upland, lowland, organic, conventional and tenanted and every type of farm continues to carry out a huge amount of work to protect and enhance the landscape, encourage wildlife, benefit soil and water and reduce the impact on the climate. With agriculture occupying over 70% of the UK landmass, farm businesses play an irreplaceable role in looking after our cherished natural environment. Farmers are custodians of the countryside and are well practiced in the words of Minette Batters, the National Farmers Union President, 'at balancing its needs while producing safe, affordable, traceable food'.

At a recent meeting with Farmers in Lancashire I asked them what were the joys in farming today. Answers varied from taking enormous pride in the production of food. There is something joyous about being a custodian of a farm—it's just 'my turn'. Every farmer I talked to, said we don't feel that we own the land, but look after it for society, wanting to hand it on to the next generation in a slightly better condition. Another said, 'I am passionate about environmental stability. We are custodians of the land which is God's creation'.

I share this article for a number of reasons. There is a disconnect in our society between rural and urban – the distance between field and fork is huge and we all need food. We need to educate more people about where our food comes from, how it is farmed, the high welfare standards which we have in this country for our animals. The National Farmers Union has set a welcome target that farming should reach net zero across England and Wales by 2040, ten years ahead of the government target. This is certainly

achievable and more about that on another occasion.

Twentieth century Dutch theologian Abraham Kuyper said, 'There is not a square inch of the entire creation over which Jesus Christ does not declare, "This is mine." In light of Christ's special relationship with creation, we have a unique calling to care for creation and the farming community do so through being its Custodians.'

Could I urge you to do something very simple as I asked the Methodist community in the Lancashire District to thank a farmer by word, email, letter or card, for the food they produce whether meat or arable and for the way they are Custodians of the land we see and enjoy today. It would mean so much.

'Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.' (John 1 v3)

Oh, the life of the world is a joy and a treasure,





Since our last AGM, it's good to say that we got going again with face to face meetings and we've got healthy numbers in each section. We also managed this against a backdrop of not been eligible for any of the £10k payments those groups that own a premises got.



During the lockdown time we met via zoom and did various games and activities remotely with the young people, until we could meet again face to face.

During the last term we enjoyed meeting in and around the village using Centenary Wood, the SRA and village green. Here we went for walks, enjoyed bike rides, played games, learnt new skills and beat the parents in a rounders match.

It has been a difficult year for all of us with the extra restrictions being placed on how we offer Scouting to young people, but the leaders have all done amazingly well. We've had to source outdoor meeting places, write covid risk assessments and deliver meetings in a different way. So I'd like to finish by saying a big thank you to the Leaders for all they have done and continue to do for Scouting in Hutton Cranswick.

We believe in bringing people together to enjoy fun, friendship and adventure in a place they can belong.

Food Bank relocates

Love Driffield is a relatively new charity but the work began in 2012 through the starting of a church based Food Pantry. We have a fantastic team of volunteers who have mainly come to us through our connection with Churches Together in Driffield and SMILE. Our team come from a variety of backgrounds with a variety of gifts and abilities. We service a large area of East Riding and have had people coming to us from further afield.

The aim of the Driffield and Wolds Food Bank is to provide emergency food for those who have found themselves in crisis. Without this charitable work many people in our community would have nowhere to turn for help. Our charity engages with some of the most vulnerable individuals and families in the community.

Success will be determined by helping our clientele out of crisis so that they no longer need our support.

We work with approximately 15 frontline agencies who have told us they would not be able to do their work effectively if it was not for the food that we are able to provide. We allow clients to drop-in to see us if they are unable to secure a voucher from a frontline worker. Many clients come back to us after we have helped them sometimes for a chat and other times to donate food or money in gratitude for the help they themselves received.

Our aspiration is to see people moving away from needing a Food Bank. Our long term goal is to provide crisis food parcels, budgeting help, job search, CV writing assistance, cooking lessons and any other project that becomes necessary to help us with this goal. We acknowledge that there will always be some that will need support throughout their lives and partnering with front-line agencies we would want to be part of the safety net that catches them.

You may have heard, that the Food Bank has now taken a lease for five years at the old Auction Rooms on the Dee & Atkinson site in Driffield.

Our opening hours are Monday and Thursday 10-12 but we are also open for deliveries on Wednesday mornings (but not to the general public).

Meantime please do keep an eye out for anyone who might be struggling and any promotion of the Food Bank within your area would be much appreciated.
