## Two Parish Councillor Vacancies

Following the recent Local Council Election process the Parish Council is seeking to fill two vacancies by co-option at its Meeting of the Parish Council on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

No special qualification is required to be a councillor but you have to be:

- a British subject, or a citizen of the Commonwealth or the European Union
- over 18 years of age

and additionally, you have to be **one** of the following

- a local government elector for the council area for which you want to stand
- have during the whole of the 12 months occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the council area or within 3 miles of it for the whole period
- have during that same period had your principal or only place of work in the council area or within 3 miles of it for the whole period.

So, if you are passionate about your community, have innovative ideas for the council, have concerns about specific issues and want to do something about them, then grasp this opportunity and join the Parish Council.

Candidates will be asked to give a short statement about why they are interested in the joining the Council and the Parish Council will make its decision by a majority vote.

You are disqualified from being elected or being a councillor if you:

- a) hold any paid office or employment (other than the office of chairman, vice chairman or deputy chairman) to which you have been appointed by the council or any committee or sub-committee of the council, or by a paid officer of the council, or by any joint committee on which the council is represented;
- b) are the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order, an interim bankruptcy restrictions order, a debt relief restrictions order or an interim debt relief restrictions order under Schedule 4ZB of the Insolvency Act 1986;
- c) have within five years before the day of election or since election been convicted of any offence and sentenced to a term of imprisonment of at least three months (whether suspended or not) without the option of a fine; or
- d) have been found guilty of corrupt or illegal practices, or were responsible for incurring unlawful expenditure and the court orders disqualification.
